A voluntary part-time Youth Centre is supported in Bembridge. Street Youth Workers also operate in Ryde, Newport, Sandown and Cowes.</p> <p>The Youth Service also supports and works in partnership with Challenge &amp; Adventure, Mobile Youth Activities, Island Youth Water Activities Centre, the Duke of Edinburgh's Award and voluntary youth groups.</p> <p>All staff are appropriately trained, qualified and CRB checked.</p> <p>The Service also works in partnership with other agencies including the Police, Teenage Pregnancy/Health Promotion, CAHMS, Schools and other Council departments.</p>
