<b>Service aims:</b>	MY-I with its bus operates in the parts of the Island where there is no established youth service provision. The bus provides a safe and warm place for young people to meet and to explore the issues which concern them. MY-I also works with teenage parents particularly young men through the Fathers First Project.
<b>To access the support:</b>	The bus currently operates in Chale Green, Wroxall and Totland, young people 13-19 years are welcome to 'drop in', Fathers First is normally by referral through the Teenage Pregnancy Advisor or Connexions Sexual Health Advisor.
<b>Method of support:</b>	<p>On the bus there will be 2/3 youth workers who will work with young people 'on board' during an evening, the 'agenda' is largely open and will be both proactive and responsive to the needs of young people.</p> <p>Fathers First meets the teenage parents wherever it is most suitable on an individual basis or as 'mum and dad' as appropriate.</p>
