Service aims:	Challenge and Adventure is a Crime Prevention Initiative; all new groups decide on their own ground rules and those of the project, i.e. No Offending; No Alcohol; No Bullying; No Drugs
To access the support:	Young people of 12 - 16 years including those in Year 8 at Middle school are referred to the project by anyone, although mainly by Schools, Education Welfare Officer, Youth Offending Team, Youth Workers, Social Services, Police Officers.
Method of support:	<p>THE CHALLENGES - 12 weeks long</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Meet one evening each week • At The Keep, Shorwell Youth Centre • Usually from 6.00pm to 8.00pm • 8-10 young people in a group • 1 full time 3 part time staff plus many volunteer leaders – some young some a little older! • The challenges enable young people to have the opportunity and support to take part in exciting activities including: <p>High Ropes - Cooking - Camping - First Aid - Climbing - Expeditions - Bivouacking - Quads - Abseiling - Adventure - Fishing - Canoeing - Biscuit Eating! - Residential week in Wales - Hill Walking - The Internet - Making Friends - Plus Many More!</p> <p>At the successful completion of each Challenge those young people who want to can remain with the Project and on a different evening each week meet to plan and take part in other activities of their choice, including the Duke of Edinburgh's Award Scheme.</p> <p>International opportunities exist when the Project occasionally takes part in Exchanges with countries in Europe.</p>
